## CALDWELL ANNOUNCES RAIL STATION DESIGN CONTRACT AWARD

Acting Mayor Kirk Caldwell announced that the City has awarded a \$5.5 million design contract for three rail transit stations to HDR/Hawaii Pacific Engineers. The contract advances the designs of the West Loch, Waipahu Transit Center and Leeward Community College stations along Farrington Highway. Lester Fukuda of the firm's Honolulu office will serve as principal consultant. The company is an employeeowned architecture, engineering and consulting firm with more than 7,800 professionals in more than 185 locations worldwide.

## **2010 UH PROCUREMENT BILL**

The SAH, our association's lobbyist, opposed and killed the bill to exempt the UH from the state procurement process as well as the General Contractor's Associations legislative bill reducing the number of subcontractor licenses, up to 16. Discussion was presented to not publically oppose a resolution that sets up a task force to make recommendations and it calls for a Senate Resolution for the SAH to nominate five individuals to serve on the task. This would allow our voices to be heard.

#### HAWAII INSTITUTE FOR PUBLIC AFFAIRS SUMMIT State of Physical Infrastructure in Hawaii

On July 13th the HIPA held a conference to report on their findings a it pertains to the status of the state's infrastructure. Some of the key points presented are:

A conservative expense of \$14.3 billion is needed in 6 years for improved infrastructure in Hawaii. The Federal government will assist as much as possible.

Hawaii's construction industry has the highest unemployment – twice the nation's average.

Unemployment is down 25% in three years. Hawaii has 41,700 unemployed based on a labor pool of 636,800.

Construction wages and benefits are 150% higher than other industries. Prediction is that unemployment will be reduced to 2.8% by end of 2010 and construction jobs will increase by 4% in 2011.

State currently has \$1.83 billion projects for capital improvement.
